1: 2: 3: 4:

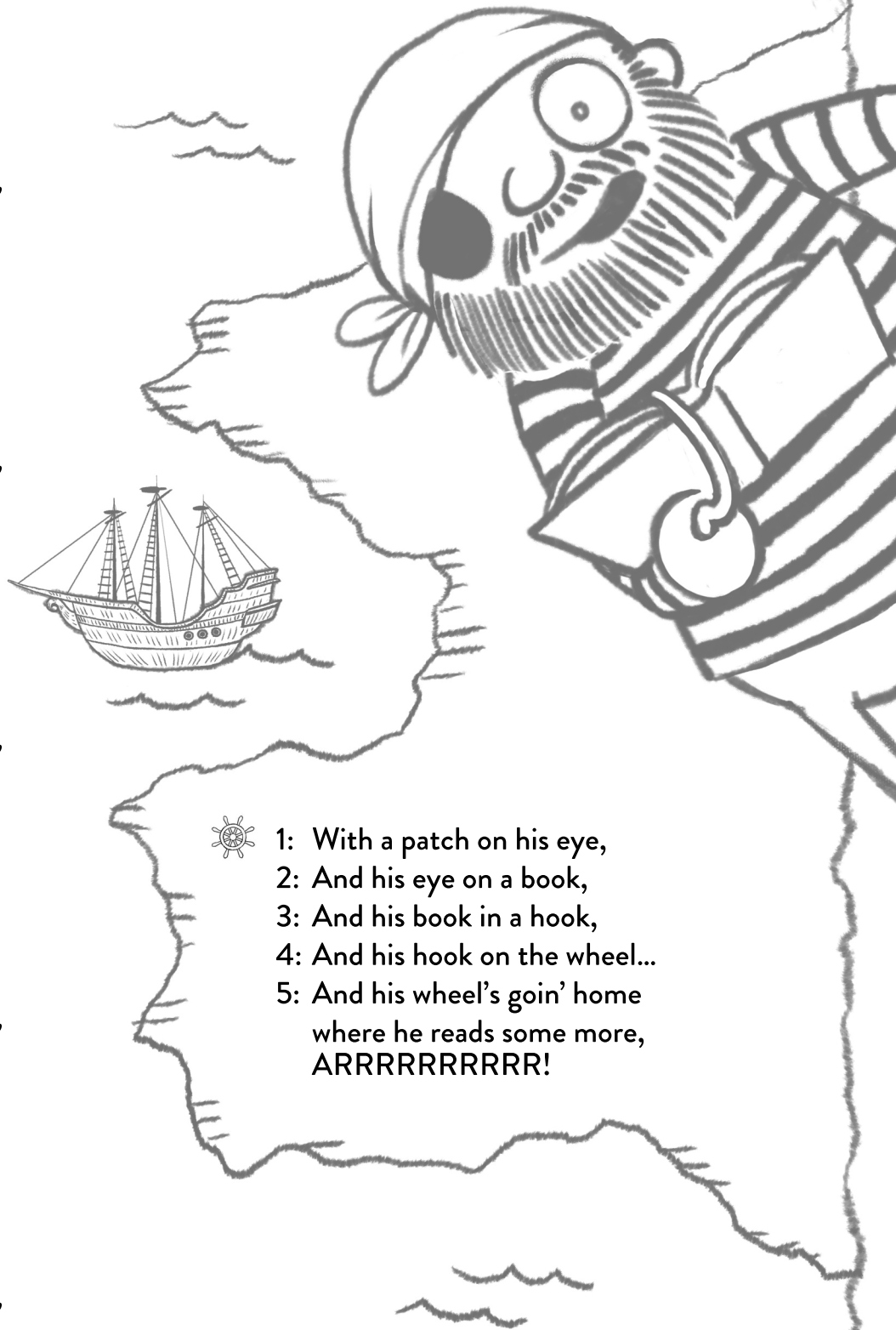
*Oh the pirate reads at sea, at sea,
